



Correct wording for a Bequest

If you decide to leave a Bequest to The Cancer Council ACT the correct wording you should use is set below:

“I GIVE the (whole or residue or percentage) of my estate to The Cancer Council ACT (ACN 113296601) of 5 Richmond Avenue, Fairbairn, ACT, 2609, for its general purposes and the receipt of the treasurer or secretary of The Cancer Council ACT will be sufficient discharge to my Executors.”

OR

“I GIVE the sum of (insert the actual amount in words and figures) to The Cancer Council ACT (ACN 113296601) of 5 Richmond Avenue, Fairbairn, ACT, 2609, for its general purposes and the receipt of the treasurer or secretary of The Cancer Council ACT will be sufficient discharge to my Executors.”
