

SunSmart Outdoor Workplace Information Session outline.



Occupational Ultraviolet Radiation (UVR) exposure is a major OH&S hazard for all Australians who work outdoors for part of or all of the day. Over-exposure to solar UVR is a major cause of skin cancer.

Who should attend the session?

All indoor and outdoor workers

What will the session cover?

The case for sun protection in the workplace.

Who conducts the session?

The SunSmart Service Coordinator from Cancer Council ACT.

How long is the session?

A standard session is about 1 hour. Discussion and question time is taken into consideration
