

Palliative, Hospice and Respite Care Services

Palliative care is treatment that aims to promote comfort, relieve symptoms and maximise quality of life when a cure for a life-threatening illness is not possible. Palliative care can be provided at home or in a hospital or hospice.

A hospice is a place that provides comprehensive care for people with incurable disease. Respite care is a short-term arrangement that allows the carer and patient to have a break from their usual care routine.

Palliative care services provided by public hospitals are covered by Medicare. Private hospitals charge for their services and most costs are covered by private health insurance. Public patients should take note that some private hospitals can offer services at subsidised cost depending on circumstances. Ask about costs when you apply to any hospital or palliative care, hospice or respite care service.
